Dear Applicant:

Salmon River Electric Cooperative (SREC) is offering two separate scholarships for 2012.

1. A \$4,000 scholarship to graduating seniors of Challis High School, former graduates of Challis High School and/or community home-schooled students pursuing academic work. This scholarship will be paid out \$1,000 each year to the recipient for up to four consecutive years. The scholarship money for the first year will be presented upon submittal of an official transcript verifying that the student is enrolled full time at an accredited college. The succeeding three years will be paid out \$1,000 each year with an official transcript documenting the recipient has achieved at least a 3.0 GPA and evidence that the recipient has registered as a full time student for the next year. Failure to achieve at least a 3.0 GPA in any year will result in forfeiture of that year's scholarship and any remaining scholarship years. The scholarship recipient is eligible to reapply for the scholarship.

To apply for this scholarship, you must submit a completed application form (attached), a high school, home-schooled or college transcript, two letters of recommendation and a written essay.

In the essay you must explain what course of study you intend to pursue in college, why you selected that course of study, and why being selected to receive a Salmon River Electric Cooperative (SREC) scholarship would be important to you.

2. A \$5,000 scholarship to any person, including graduating seniors, who is interested in pursuing a lineman career. One half of the scholarship money will be presented for tuition use upon verification that the recipient is enrolled in an approved lineman college and one half will be paid upon completion after submission of a certificate of completion. Upon completion of the schooling, the recipient is encouraged to work for SREC should a position become open but is under no obligation to work for SREC.

To apply for this scholarship, you must submit a completed application form (attached), a high school, home-schooled or college transcript, two letters of recommendation and a written essay.

In the essay you must explain why being selected to receive a Salmon River Electric Cooperative (SREC) scholarship would be important to you.

The selection of the recipients of both scholarships will be based upon the above criteria. Please make sure you have submitted all the required information stated to ensure eligibility. Applications must be received at the SREC office by March 16, 2012. Successful applicants must enroll within the calendar year of receipt of the scholarship or forfeit the scholarship.
